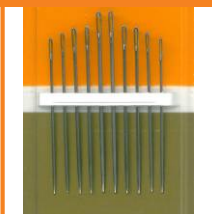

**Before you start processing the interlining, Vilene recommends making an ironing sample to check the handle and the bond.**

**After ironing, lay the fused parts flat and allow to cool for 20 to 30 minutes.**

Use a firm, even surface for fusing, such as a working table. If you use an ironing board, you can improve the result by putting a pressing cloth below. You will find more detailed processing instructions for Vilene products on the blue edge print.











### General instructions for Use

Before commencing work the furnishing fabric should be ironed all over using steam in order to counteract any shrinkage. The interlining should only be ironed on when the fabric has dried out again completely.

**Vilene recommends making up an ironing sample before fusing, to check that the fabric surface and bond meet your requirements.**

### Cleaning the pelmet

Depending on the outer fabric, pelmets made with Vilene interlinings are either dry cleaned or washed by laying them flat in a solvent or detergent solution. They can also be rolled on to a perforated hollow cylinder and either dry cleaned or washed using a gentle wash cycle and protected by a laundry bag.
